1. ABOUT THE TRIENNALE

Oku-Noto Triennale is a new Triennale which will be held at Suzu City located at the tip of Noto Peninsula. Although Suzu has been facing depopulation and ageing due to its disadvantaged geographical location, distinctive living, festivals and cultures have been nurtured under the influence of maritime trade on the Sea of Japan including Japanese missions to Tang China, official envoys from Bokkai, and the routes plied by kitamae-bune from ancient to modern times.
